All the riders spent time learning or perfecting their cattle skills as we worked on horsemanship first, then moved the cows from the round pens to the warmup arena and worked on moving, sorting, holding, cutting them with just our riders on horseback. We were also fortunate



to have one of the riders bring her mechanical cow for us to use as Richard taught us how to ride parallel with the flag, stop, draw back in a straight line, turn with the flag and follow it. The weekend ended with lots of sorting practice on Sunday afternoon.
